Notice: Automotive Incentive Program Transportation Incentive Rate Change Q3, 2011

Effective July 1, 2011, Stewardship Ontario will be reducing the Transportation Incentive for Automotive Plastics.

In April 2010 based on the collection shortages of Automotive Plastics the decision was made to increase the Transportation and Processing incentives by approx. 30% to increase the amount of plastic collected for diversion.

During the past year we have been watching the collection rates closely and due to the rapid increase during the past year and the continuing trend YTD 2011 we have deemed it necessary to reduce the "Transportation" incentive by 15% effective July 1, 2011.

We are sensitive to the fuel prices that are on the rise and have agreed that because of this we will only take a 15% reduction at this time. We will continue to monitor the collection volumes and make any further necessary adjustments in the future.

Effective July 1, 2011, Stewardship Ontario will be reducing the Transportation Incentive for Antifreeze by 15%.

Since the beginning of the year we have been watching collection rates closely and due to antifreeze material management costs exceeding budget, we have deemed it necessary to reduce the "Transportation" incentive by 15% effective July 1, 2011.

We are sensitive to the fuel prices that are on the rise and have agreed that because of this we will only take a 15% reduction at this time. We will continue to monitor the collection volumes and make any further necessary adjustments in the future.
